

# SAFATEX Sigma SL1000 - User manual



Supplied with an AC charger and shoulder strap.

## Charging:



The charging socket is located at the back of the searchlight. (8 hours charging time).



Red = Battery charging  
Green = Fully charged



Digital battery display shows the % of battery capacity while being charged.

## Operating:

Switch



Press the switch to turn the searchlight on and select the mode you require (High/low/flashing).



## Flashing mode (20hrs):

When the searchlight is turned off press and hold the mode switch for 3 seconds, press again to turn the light off.



When the searchlight is turned **ON** the digital battery display will show the % of battery capacity.



## Shoulder Strap:

The searchlight is supplied with a shoulder strap making it comfortable to carry the searchlight, whilst keeping your hands free to perform other tasks.

**Warranty:** The Sigma SL1000 comes with a 2-years warranty on all manufacturing defects and rechargeable batteries, from the date of purchase.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION:

- Never submerge in water. If you suspect the unit has water inside, do not use or attempt to recharge.
- DO NOT DROP THE SEARCHLIGHT. Dropping may damage the battery cells or circuit components inside.
- The battery will not reach optimum performance until 4-5 charging cycles, we recommend the battery is recharged every 6 months if not used regularly.
- For maximum performance and added safety, we recommend you replace your battery every 3 years. The battery should only be replaced with NightSearcher Lithium-Ion batteries, these are certificated to all relevant safety standards.
- Never use the charger if the leads, contacts or casings are damaged.
- Do not use any chargers other than those provided. If you suspect any of these have occurred then do not use the charger.
- Do not shine the light directly into people's eyes, as it may damage their eyesight.
- Keep out of reach of children.
